



# Food and drink inflation comparison with Europe









Crude oil (\$/bbl) and natural gas (\$/mmbtu)






### Freightos Baltic Index (FBX): Global Container Freight Index



#### Straight fertilisers, 2020 = 100










Potatoes, 2020 = 100
